Coaching Director Named for 2016-17 Season

Coach Brad Shaver has been appointed as coaching director for the CP Dynamo Bantam and Midget AAA levels for the present and 2016 - 2017 season.

Tryouts For 2016-17 Dynamo

Though Spring is a couple of months away, it will arrive faster than you think. Dynamo tryouts are typically held shortly after the conclusion of the season for the next. If your player is interested in trying out for a position on one of our Dynamo teams, you will want to consider the following:

Q: What is the difference between the Eagles and Dynamo teams?

A: Dynamo is, in general terms, an advanced program of hockey. This is what is called a triple-A (AAA) level, which typically involves travel at greater distances and a bit of a longer training season. Head coaches are selected annually, as are team players. Player selection is based upon a set of criteria that surpasses simple skill, such as teamwork and goodness of fit within the developing team.

Q: Who can try out?

A: Dynamo teams start at the Squirt (10U) level and include all levels through Midgets (18U). Tryouts are not limited to CPYHA players; any qualified player may try out regardless of this year's affiliation. Team selections will be made on several factors in addition to skill, such as team need, dynamic, player sense of teamwork and determination, etc. Even if you are not certain Dynamo is for you, the tryout experience alone is valuable. Your player will likely participate in many future tryouts over their career, and experience is a plus.

Q: How are tryouts run?

A: Tryouts are historically a two-day process, lasting approximately 60-90 minutes each. It is strongly encouraged that candidates attend BOTH sessions for adequate evaluation time. Players are issued tryout jerseys for this purpose; all candidates will be identified by number only. Jerseys must be returned at the conclusion of the last session (we clean them for you). Sessions are closed; only coaches and evaluators are allowed in the rink during sessions. Individual results will not be provided by the selection team; all candidates will be notified directly once teams are determined. Players not selected for a Dynamo team, or who reject an offer, always have a spot on an equivalent Eagles team for the season, and are welcome to try out again for future seasons.

Tryout dates & times will be announced toward the end of this season. If you <u>plan to attend</u> tryouts, **please advise our <u>registrar</u>** Kathleen Shumpert as early as possible so she may coordinate with our director, selection team and equipment manager accordingly. This will allow for efficient check-in, full ice time, and less stress for players on those days.
